Dear Customer,

Your home/apartment will be treated for FLEAS on _____.

PREPARATION FOR PROPER APPLICATION OF OUR PRODUCTS IS AS FOLLOWS:

INTERIOR: COMPLETELY VACUUM ALL OF YOUR CARPETS. If you plan to chemically clean your carpets, please do so at least 24 hours prior to our service time. Do not clean afterwards. Vacuum under and between all cushions; in closets, under beds and under all furniture. Dispose of vacuum bag and/or contents IMMEDIATELY.

EXTERIOR: All PET FECES must be eliminated at all times (these serve as breeding grounds for fleas). Animal hairs in the cracks of concrete or edgings should be removed. Landscaping must be maintained regularly. Watering should be done the day before and then resumed 1-3 days after treatment.

PETS: Dogs/cats should be taken to a PROFESSIONAL GROOMER for a flea treatment the same day you have an appointment with our company. Pet bedding is to be laundered in very hot soapy water, with a repeat done once a week. If old - DISCARD - this will keep infestation from reoccurring.

VACATE THE PREMISES AS FOLLOWS: DO NOT ENTER RESIDENCE UNTIL THE PRODUCT IS COMPLETELY DRIED AND VENTILATED!! Normally, treated premises should be vacated a minimum of 4 to 6 hours. Special precautions may be necessary for young children, pregnant women, the elderly, and residents with health issues including, but not limited to, upper respiratory problems and asthma. These residents should contact their personal physician for recommended re-entry time. Pets should also be out of residence until product completely dries and ventilates. Some animals require longer vacating times due to their respiratory systems (birds/reptiles). Check with your veterinarian for appropriate re-entry times. Please seal all fish aquariums.

VENTILATION: We recommend ventilating your residence before returning by opening a few windows and/or doors.

AFTER TREATMENT: Regular vacuuming at 24 hour intervals for 7 to 10 days after treatment is recommended. Keep floors clean as well. This will help reduce the flea population. Professional fleas baths for pets and treatment of pets with Advantage, Frontline, etc. (available through your veterinarian) are also recommended .
