



Dear Customer,

Your home/apartment will be treated for BEDBUGS on _____.

PREPARATION FOR PROPER APPLICATION OF OUR PRODUCTS IS AS FOLLOWS:

COMPLETELY REMOVE ALL BEDDING FROM ALL MATTRESSES. Bedding should be completely laundered and not put back onto mattresses until treatment is completed. Mattresses and box springs should be stood up on end so that they can be thoroughly treated. After inspection, if mattresses and box springs are found to be infested and untreatable, you will be asked to discard them. Dresser drawers and end table drawers should be pulled out and completely emptied. All clothing from drawers and closets should be washed before being put away. Please bag clothing (large trash bags are fine) after laundering until the treatment is complete. Furniture and other items should be pulled away from walls. Furniture should have cushions off and furniture tipped up for treatment. All areas should be thoroughly vacuumed including carpets, base boards and furniture. Vacuum bags should be discarded or vacuum cylinders should be emptied. Remove electrical cover plates to allow for wall void dusting.

VACATE THE PREMISES AS FOLLOWS: DO NOT ENTER RESIDENCE UNTIL THE PRODUCT IS COMPLETELY DRIED AND VENTILATED!! Normally, treated premises should be vacated a minimum of 4 to 6 hours. Special precautions may be necessary for young children, pregnant women, the elderly, and residents with health issues including, but not limited to, upper respiratory problems and asthma. These residents should contact their personal physician for recommended re-entry time. Pets should also be out of residence until product completely dries and ventilates. Some animals require longer vacating times due to their respiratory systems (birds/reptiles). Check with your veterinarian for appropriate re-entry times. Please seal all fish aquariums.

VENTILATION: We recommend ventilating your residence before returning by opening a few windows and/or doors.

AFTER TREATMENT: Drawers can be closed and refilled. Mattresses and box springs can be put back into their frames after the product is **COMPLETELY DRY**. If you see any evidence of bedbugs after 30 days, call our office.

**State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION-PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control Companies are registered and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Pesticide Regulation and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by benefits. The degree of risk depends on the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized. If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to the flu, contact your physician or the Poison Control Center (800) 876-4766 and your pest control company immediately. In the case of anticoagulants, materials may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding.
